An individual is considered to be in a crisis when they are faced with an event or situation that they deem too big for them to handle due to personal inadequacies and/or limited resources and it exceeds their tolerance capabilities (James & Gilliland 2005, p. 19). Crisis intervention is therefore the immediate help offered by a professional with the objective of helping the persons in crisis – client – to reestablish pre-crisis situation or achieve equilibrium (Echterling et al., 2005).
